Nashville Auto Diesel College Career Days

The NADC **Career Day** is an opportunity to put your company in front of about 1,700 students who are attending school at NADC. This is a great way to build awareness of your company in the NADC student body and staff.

**The Career Days in 2011 will be held on
April 6 & 7 and October 5 & 6, 2011.**

For Career Day, seventy plus companies will set up booths in the Tech Center. We provide an 8' table and space for each. Each company can request a specific space in the hall and we will honor these requests on a first-come-first-served basis.

Most companies will bring some type of display to "show off" and catch the students' attention. **If you plan to bring an equipment display, please contact Career Services. Because of growth and increased participation, positioning of equipment displays will be assigned prior to day of event.** Many companies will bring brochures, business cards, and "trinkets" to distribute. All will be interested in talking to NADC students about the value of employment with their company. Some companies just want to become familiar with activities on the NADC campus. Some have students fill out applications on the spot and return them. Some companies take names of interested students and make plans for follow-up visits at their service location. Dress for the event will be business casual.

Participating companies will receive the names, hometowns, and states of all students who attend the event prior to the start of the activity. We will also supply you with copies of current grade sheets for any student in whom you are interested. Additionally, a few companies will bring enough "manpower" to be able to work the booth and have someone talking one-on-one with students in a remote and private interview session. This must be arranged with the Career Services Staff ahead of time so that we can assign and set up interview locations.

The display area will be open to our afternoon shift students during the mid-afternoon on the first day (Wednesday) of the Career Days. The hall will open for morning shift students again around 9:00 AM on the second day (Thursday). The job fair will be over before noon. Exhibitors may begin to set up at noon on Wednesday and dismantling begins at 11:30 AM.

We hope our Career Days will be informative for companies, students, and alumni alike. It is our goal to facilitate communication between your company and NADC graduates, and the Career Services Staff will assist you in achieving this goal.

Nashville Auto Diesel College Presentation Days

Each year NADC makes available a limited number of days for potential employers to come to our campus to speak to soon-to-be graduates. On **Presentation Days**, one company per day is invited to speak with NADC students. Following the company's presentation, any student who is interested in employment can sign up for a one-on-one interview with the company's representative. On these days you will have the undivided attention of the NADC student body and the Career Services Staff.

The recruiting year is broken down into "peak" and "non-peak" periods. During the peak season you can generally expect to have about 100 students attend both the morning and afternoon sessions (200 total for the day). During the non-peak season, students scheduled to graduate within the next 3-4 months from the areas where your company has service locations will be in the room to listen to your remarks.

The peak season will run from May 1, 2011 through October 31, 2011. All dates that are available can be found on the attached 2011 NADC Recruiting Calendar. Presentation Days can be scheduled after discussion with the Director of Career Services.

The Career Services Office is located on campus next to a room that will seat about 100 students. Since we have both a morning and an afternoon shift for our students, most companies plan to make a morning presentation at 9:30 AM followed by interviews. The afternoon presentation is generally done at 2:30 PM followed by interviews for afternoon students. Presentations will be limited to 30 minutes followed by questions and answers by the attending students. Our facility will support PowerPoint shows including audio, and DVD's.

Following each session, students are invited to greet the company representative(s) and to discuss any element of the presentation. This practice allows even the most introverted student a fair opportunity to discuss relevant matters in a non-threatening format. This time period also allows the Career Services Staff time to schedule interviews and gather documentation for each interested student wishing to do an interview. Students will be dressed in an open neck uniform shirt and most often visitors will dress in business casual attire.

In the rear of the Presentation Room are two interview booths. Generally companies schedule a fifteen-minute interview with each interested student; however other arrangements can be made with the Career Services Director prior to the start of the day. Students come into the interview with their grade sheet, a copy of the manufacturer's certificates they have earned, and a resume if it has already been completed. If required, each student can complete an application for the company during the course of the session.

The dates for presentations are available on a first-come-first-served basis to interested companies.
